Membership FAQ:

Why did I get a renewal notice? National HQ sends out renewal notices NOT by the Post nor Adjutant. They send these out several times a year. The first goes out early July.

- **If I paid my dues in March, why did I get a renewal notice in July**? The membership year starts on 1 JULY. Your 2015 card is good until December 31 but the "dues year" is 1 Jul to 30 Jun.
- I get multiple renewal notices, why? It takes 2-3 weeks to process your dues payment through Post, State and National. If your dues were not processed before the next renewal you will get another renewal notice.
- How can I make sure NOT to get a renewal notice? The BEST way...Go and pay your dues on-line. Go to Legion.org and click on the box for "Renew Your Legion Membership Today!". You will get a receipt, the Adjutant gets notified you have paid and will send your 2016 card out to you.
- Why do I have to pay Legion, SAL, ALA and ALR dues separately? Each organization has their own checking account. They each have different people doing membership. It is difficult and not easy to track money when it is comingled.
- Why is the American Legion always talking about membership numbers? The American Legion is the LARG-EST Veterans organization in the nation. This adds a lot of clout to the National Commander when he talks to Congress and the President about veteran issues (VA, Tricare, benefits, PTSD, education, etc.). This, also, holds true for the community (Converse, Bexar County, etc.) and state (Texas)!!

Supreme Court Rules on Health Care

In a 6-3 decision, the Supreme court ruled that the Affordable Care Act (ACA) can continue to provide subsidies for health insurance to qualifying individuals. The decision upheld a centerpiece of the ACA and national healthcare reform.

TRICARE beneficiaries are unaffected by the decision. At the urging of MOAA and other military and veterans organizations, Congress passed the TRICARE Affirmation Act in 2010, providing a statutory regulation saying that TRICARE satisfies the minimum essential coverage requirements of the ACA. Congress passed subsequent legislation a month later to exempt VA and CHAMPVA beneficiaries from the coverage requirements. These plans are also excluded from so-called "Cadillac taxes" on high-value plans.
